

F. Multiple alarms received before the system can be deactivated within a reasonable period of time shall be considered a single alarm as determined by the Fire Chief and/or Chief of Police.

**SECTION 4. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.**

A. Should any person fail to pay the false alarm charges, as required under Section 3 of this Ordinance, such failure shall constitute a violation of this Ordinance and such unpaid charges may be collected as fines by suit or summary proceeding brought in the name of the Borough of Tyrone before any District Justice of this Commonwealth having jurisdiction. Such proceedings for such violations and for the collection of such fees imposed herein and unpaid may be commenced by warrant or by summons, at the discretion of the District Justice before whom such proceedings are begun.

B. Any person who commits a violation shall be subject to prosecution in a summary proceeding brought before a District Justice having jurisdiction and, upon conviction, shall be liable for a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$1,000.00, plus costs of prosecution, and in default thereof, may be sentenced and committed to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days. Each day during which failure to comply continues shall constitute a separate violation of the terms of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough of Tyrone that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


**SECTION 6. REPEALER.**


All ordinance or resolution or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
