SWEARING IN CEREMONIES

COUNCIL MEMBERS

On January 2, 2018 @ 7:00pm, District Magisterial Judge Fred Miller administered oaths of office to newly elected Council members David Snyder, Sarah Jane Miller and Terry Richardson; and Mayor William Latchford. The sworn in Council members and Mayor assumed their seats on Borough Council.
