SWEARING IN CEREMONIES

COUNCIL MEMBERS

On January 3, 2012, at 7:00PM, District Magisterial Justice Fred Miller administered oaths of office to newly elected Council members Terry Richardson, Mark Black and Raymond Detwiler, all of whom were elected in November, 2011. The sworn in members assumed their seats on Borough Council.
