

ORDINANCE NO. 1350

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TYRONE, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AMENDING CHAPTER 190 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF TYRONE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO: 1. REMOVE THE PUBLIC HANDICAP PARKING SPACE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF TENTH STREET AT THE DOLLAR STORE AND ADD PUBLIC HANDICAP PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF TENTH STREET AT HUNTER AVENUE AND ON THE EAST SIDE OF LOGAN AVENUE AT HERALD STREET; AND 2. ADD STOP SIGNS ON: ALLEY B BETWEEN 9TH AND 10TH STREET EAST AND WEST BOUND ON CAMERON AND S. LINCOLN; ON WERTZ STREET EAST AND WEST BOUND AT INTERSECTION HAMILTON AVENUE; AND 3. ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Borough of Tyrone hereby ordains:

Section 1. Amendment to Chapter 190. Chapter 190 of the Code of the Borough of Tyrone entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" is hereby amended with all material to be deleted to be indicated by ~~strikethrough~~ and all material to be added indicated by underlining as hereinafter provided:

- I. Article IV entitled "Handicapped Parking", Section 190-27 entitled "Handicaped and/or disabled veteran parking spaces established" is hereby amended as follows:

- II. Article III entitle "Schedules", Section 190-60 entitled "Schedule VII: Stop Intersections" is hereby amended as follows:


Stop Sign on	Direction of Travel	At Intersection of
<u>Alley B</u>	East and West	<u>Both Cameron Ave. and S. Lincoln Ave.</u>
<u>Wertz Street</u>	East and West	<u>Hamilton Avenue</u>

Section 2. Ratification of Chapter 190. Chapter 190, except as amended hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest possible date provided by law.
