ORDINANCE NO. 1351

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TYRONE, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDIANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF TYRONE SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 190 ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", SECTION 190-20, ENTITLED "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES" TO PROHIBIT PARKING: ALONG ANY PORTION OF A CURB DESIGNATED WITH YELLOW PAINT; AGAINST TRAFFIC; WITHIN 20 FEET OF A CROSSWALK AT AN INTERSECTION; WITHIN 30 FEET UPON THE APPROACH TO ANY FLASHING SIGNAL, STOP SIGN, YIELD SIGN OR TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNAL LOCATED AT THE SITE OF A ROADWAY; WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE DRIVEWAY ENTRANCE TO ANY FIRE STATION OR, WHEN PROPERLY SIGN POSTED, ON THE SIDE OF A STREET OPPOSITE THE ENTRANCE TO ANY FIRE STATION WITHIN 75 FEET OF THE ENTRANCE; ON A LIMITED ACCESS HIGHWAY; WITHIN 50 FEET OF THE NEAREST RAIL OF A RAILROAD CROSSING; WITHIN 50 FEET OF THE NEAREST RAIL OF A RAILROAD CROSSING; AND THE ORDINANCE REAFFIRMS SECTION 190-20 AS AMENDED; CONTAINS REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY PROVISIONS AND ESTABLISHES AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Borough of Tyrone hereby ordains the following:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 190, SECTION 190-20 ENTITLED "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES".

Chapter 190, Section 190-20 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Tyrone entitled "Parking prohibited at all times" is hereby amended with all language to be added by <u>underlining</u> and all language to be deleted by <u>strikethrough</u> as follows:

§190-20. Parking prohibited at all times.

No person shall park a vehicle or allow the same to remain parked upon any of the streets or parts thereof:

- 1. That are described in Schedule XI (§190-63), attached to and made a part of this chapter.
- 2. That are designated with yellow painted curbing or in the absence of a curb, yellow painted edge of the shoulder of said street.
- 3. That would have the said vehicle parked on a two—way street facing the opposite direction of authorized traffic movement with its left-hand wheels against the left-hand curb or in the absence of a curb, against the left edge of the left-hand shoulder of said street.

- curb or in the absence of a curb, against the left edge of the left-hand shoulder of said street.
- 4. That would have the said vehicle parked on a one—way street facing the opposite direction of authorized traffic movement.
- 5. That are within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.
- 6. That are within 30 feet upon the approach to any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign or traffic-control signal located at the site of a roadway.
- 7. That are within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station or, when properly sign posted, on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within 75 feet of the entrance.
- 8. On a limited access highway (as defined under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code) unless authorized by official traffic-control devices.
- 9. Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing.
- 10. At any place where official signs prohibit parking.

SECTION 2. REAFFIRMATION OF CODE.

The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Tyrone, except as amended hereby is reaffirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough of Tyrone that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 4. REPEALER.

Any Ordinance or Resolution or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest possible date provided by law.
