Chief of Police

The Borough of Tyrone, Pennsylvania, is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Chief of Police. Tyrone Borough, a Home Rule Municipality with a population of 5,500, is accepting résumés for Chief of Police. Tyrone Borough is located in Blair County (in South Central Pennsylvania) mid-way between Altoona and State College. This is a full-time, non Civil Service, at will position with the responsibility of managing 3 full-time and an average of 10 part-time officers. Applicants must have two or more years of continuous experience in supervisory and administrative police work. Candidate must have education equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in police science, criminal justice or related field, or any equivalent combination of experience and training.
