

Pool Regulations

1. All Persons are required to shower before entering pool.
2. No intoxicating beverages or persons under the influence of intoxicants will be permitted in or about the pool.
3. Anyone with a skin disorder should check with the Guard before entering pool.
4. There shall be no profanity or rough talk around the bath house or pool area.
5. No one allowed inside pool area unless wearing swimming trunks. No cut off jeans permitted.
6. No glass allowed inside pool area at any time.
7. Do not abuse slides or other equipment.
8. No wrestling, boxing, running or "Horseplay" in pool area.
9. No throwing of persons into water from side of pool.
10. No diving except in specified areas.
11. No hanging from life lines unless necessary.
12. All play and play equipment in the pool shall be under the jurisdiction of the guards at all times.
13. No one allowed on guard stands except specified personnel.
14. All refuse shall be placed in containers located at pool side.
15. Designated hours for swimming shall be strictly adhered to.
16. Smoking is prohibited in all pool areas.
17. No food permitted to be brought into the pool area.
18. Individuals must be as least 48" tall in bare feet to use the pool slides.

These rules and regulations are for your protection. Failure to obey them will mean expulsion from the pool. The Borough reserved the right to change these regulations at any time.

Lap Swimming

Lap swimming is open to anyone interested and able to swim. Lap swimming will be circle-swimming style in one lane of the pool. The rest of the pool will be used for swimming lessons. It is up to the discretion of the guards to open or close lap lanes based upon number of children in swim lessons.

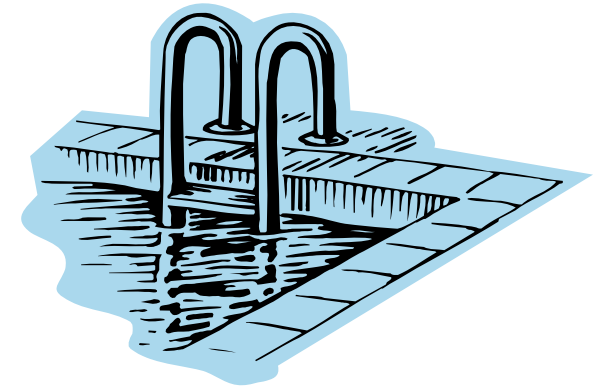

First Splash Swim School

First Splash Swim School is especially designed to give the student a pleasant and safe water experience. Each swim school session will consist of a half-hour lesson each day for 8 day classes Monday-Thursday. The cost of each session is \$25.00 per child. Pre registration is required. For more information or to pre-register call or stop at the Municipal Building, 1100 Logan Avenue, Tyrone PA, (814) 684-1330. Enrollment is limited to seven (7) children per class. To ensure a spot in the class please register early.

Toddler Class: Requirements—Swimmer must have parental accompaniment in the water for this class. Age range is 19 months to 4 years of age with no water experience.

Beginner Class: Requirements—no previous water experience needed, ages 5 and up.

Intermediate Class: Requirements—front crawl with face under water and unassisted back float, ages 6 to 12.

For daily admission rates from 5:00-8:00pm for the general public the fee will be \$2.00 for Adults 18 and over, \$1.00 for swimmers 6-17 years of age and children age 5 and under are free when accompanied with paying adult.
