

Pool Regulations

1. All Persons are required to shower before entering pool.
2. No intoxicating beverages or intoxicated persons will be permitted in or around the pool.
3. Anyone with a skin disorder should check with the Guard before entering pool.
4. There shall be no profanity or rough talk around the bath house or pool area.
5. Persons without proper swim attire are not permitted in the pool. No cut off jeans permitted.
6. No glass is allowed inside pool area at any time.
7. Do not abuse slides or other equipment.
8. No wrestling, boxing, running or "horseplay" in pool area.
9. No throwing of persons into water from side of pool.
10. No diving except in specified areas.
11. No hanging from life lines unless necessary.
12. All play and play equipment in the pool shall be under the jurisdiction of the guards at all times.
13. Pool patrons are prohibited from being on guard stands.
14. All refuse shall be placed in containers located at pool side.
15. Designated hours for swimming shall be strictly adhered to.
16. Smoking is prohibited in all pool areas.
17. No outside food is permitted inside the pool.
Baby bottles/sippy cups will be permitted.
18. **Individuals must be as least 48" tall in bare feet to use the pool slides. (This includes pool parties) NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

These rules and regulations are for your protection. Failure to obey them may result in expulsion from the pool. The Borough reserves the right to change these regulations at any time.

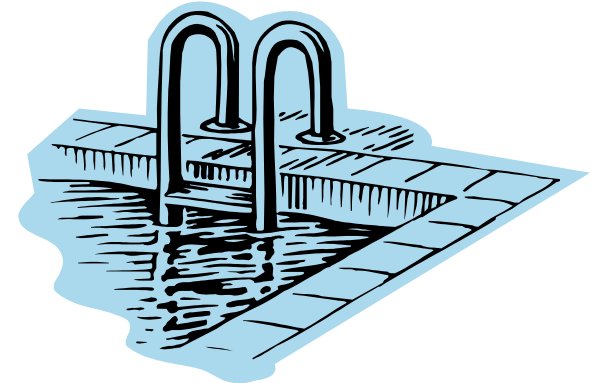

First Splash Swim School

First Splash Swim School is designed to give the child a pleasant and safe water experience. Each swim school session will consist of a half-hour lesson each day for 8 day classes, Monday-Thursday. The cost of each session is \$30.00 per child. Pre-registration is required. For more information or to pre-register, stop by the Municipal Building, 1100 Logan Avenue, Tyrone. Enrollment is limited to ten (10) children per class. To ensure a spot in the class please register early.

Toddler Class: Requirements—swimmer must have parental accompaniment in the water for this class. Age range is 19 months to 4 years of age with no water experience.

Beginner Class: Requirements—no previous water experience needed. Age range is 5 years and up.

Intermediate Class: Requirements—front crawl with face under water and unassisted back float. Age range is 6 to 12 years.

Open Family Swimming

Family swimming is open to the public. Bring your favorite water toys and enjoy a day of family fun. Admission to family swim for the general public is \$5.00 for adults 18 and over, \$4.00 for swimmers 6-17 years of age and children age 5 and under are free when accompanied by a paying adult.

Evening Rates

Evening admission rates from 5pm-8pm, are \$2.00 for adults 18 and over, \$1.00 for swimmers 6-17 years of age and children age 5 and under are free when accompanied by a paying adult.
